- supporting teachers in the classroom
- camps, excursions, Breakfast Club and school life
- supporting voluntary student groups

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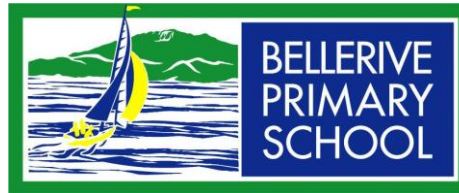
